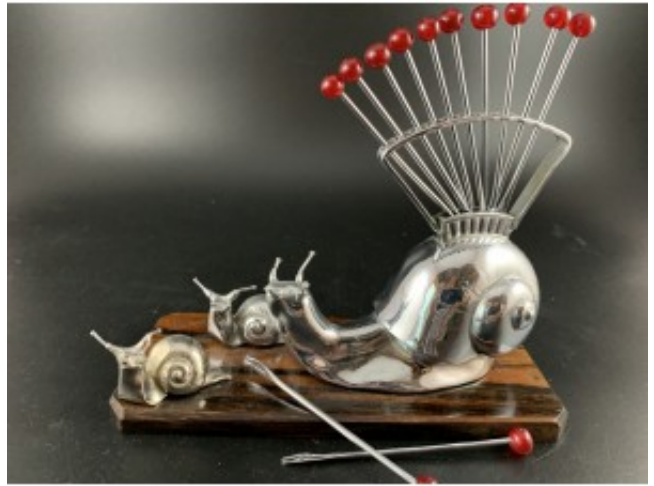

This vintage bar pick holder was made in France and featured in the December 2010 issue of the magazine Country Living! 1930s, This snail set with cocktail sticks I was told was designed by the French illustrator Benjamin Rabier who also designed barware. This cocktail stick set has a beautiful wooden base with 3 chromed metal snails - 1 large and 2 little - and 12 sticks with each a red bakelite top.
