Wonderful cocktail picks in an arched metal holder over a beautiful wooden slat. The picks are topped with great figures of parrots, birds, maybe a pink elephant and Scottie dogs watched over another Scottie. My set of these were featured in the December 2010 issue of the magazine Country Living! The back side of these has clip to attach them to the glass so they don't slide under. I am pretty sure it is missing one pick since there is an extra hole but otherwise, wonderful!

Scotties Scottish terriers, like the ones included in this menagerie, show up as a recurring motif in 1930s and '40s collectibles (the popularity of FDR's beloved Scottie, Fala, contributed heavily to the trend). The lack of a maker's mark caps this set's value at \$45, while a missing member brings the price down another 10 bucks. Incomplete sets are common—as Visakay points out: "You know what happens at parties"
